S. Lloyd Natof grew up on a small farm in northern Virginia. His last two years of high school were spent at Sandy Spring Friends School where he discovered what would be an abiding appreciation of the arts and began to consider the role they might play in his life.

Summer of 1983 found him moving to Chicago to be with a sweetheart and attend college. During his

first year at the University of Chicago he decided to pursue music and spent the next two years practicing. In 1986 he entered the DePaul School of Music as a Jazz Studies (flute) major. It was in his second to last year there that he started building furniture – mostly pieces for himself with an occasional commission. The experience of working in a tactile medium was immediately satisfying and he began to set up his own shop.

Now, Lloyd designs and builds furniture from a spacious 2nd floor atelier in an old factory building on the near west side of Chicago. Since moving here in 1989 he has earned a reputation for elegant design with precise woodworking. Working on a commission basis, he has created pieces for private collectors, architects, businesses and interior as well as liturgical designers.

In 1995, Lloyd bought his first press and now specializes in veneered furniture and casework, selecting and applying the wood veneer himself.
